Minutes of the Committee of the Whole meeting held on Monday, August 12, 2019, in the City Hall Council Chambers, Melfort, Saskatchewan, commencing at 4:29 p.m.

BRUNSWICK SCHOOL CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS

The Committee of the Whole reviewed the Brunswick School Crossing Improvements report dated July, 2019, prepared by Catterall & Wright, which notes that a 4-way stop is not warranted at the Bemister Ave E/Scotia St intersection, but recommends a curb extension/bulb-out, raised centre refuge island and a raised crosswalk. The Director will write a letter to the North East School Division advising that the engineer also recommends that this intersection be supervised by school crossing guards. Speed humps are also an option in the future if there is a need.

The Committee recommends the reallocation of capital funds from the airport lighting project to complete the improvements at the Bemister Avenue East/Scotia Street intersection and the Bemister Avenue East sidewalk from Scotia Street to Brunswick Street. Improvements at the remaining intersections will be brought to the 2020 capital budget for discussion.
