



**NOTICE TO RESIDENTS OF:
CASKEY DRIVE, LANCASTER
STREET & HAMILTON AVE.**

RE: WATERLINE REPLACEMENT

Dear Resident(s):

Waterline replacement will be done on your street this summer. This will involve:

Installation of temporary water line along the sidewalks, with connections made to the outside tap of your home. Inside your home the contractor will be turning off the valve under the water meter. This valve is your responsibility and if for some reason it does not work properly you will be required to repair it. When your temporary service is initially installed, we advise that you run some water through it in order to flush out the line. With this procedure being followed, your potable water system will function normally for the duration of the temporary service.

Construction will involve the following:

1. The asphalt will be loaded onto trucks and hauled to our salvage pile located at the corner of McDonald Ave and Shadd Drive.
2. Crews will start to dig up and replace the main water line. This will involve digging down approximately 3.0 meters. After the water line has been replaced, another crew will start to excavate approximately .500-.750 meters in depth to accommodate new granular material.
3. The street will be brought up to original grade with gravel. Pavement will be offered as a Local Improvement in the 2011.
4. Garbage will be picked up as regular. If your garbage is picked up in the front please try to keep the can on the edge of your property. Back lane pick up is as usual. Have your garbage out by 7:30am.

During this time you will have to find alternate parking if the crew is working in front of or close to your home. Barricades will be in place to restrict traffic. This construction process can take one to two weeks, depending on the weather. The contractor will be working 11 days on and 3 days off to minimize the disruption.

If you need special arrangements during this time, please call our office at the number below and we will make every attempt to make this go as smoothly as possible.

We encourage all parents to watch their children closely due to large equipment working and the depth of the excavation. Barricades will be installed at night, but care must be taken that no small children are left unsupervised.

When the date of your waterline replacement gets closer, a city employee/contractor representative will be going door-to-door to notify you (or if you are not at home at the time, a note will be left on your door).
